The Graduate School of Science and Technology (GSST) at Kumamoto University offers the International Joint Education Program for Science and Technology (IJEP) for international postgraduate students pursuing Master's degrees in the following research and educational fields. Enrollment is either in April or in October. The main language of this program for classes and research is English. Basic Japanese language courses are offered at the Center for International Education. The standard period of enrollment is two years with some exceptions.

Degrees

Master of Science, Master of Engineering, Master of Informatics, or Master of Philosophy will be conferred.

Fees and Tuition

Examination fee: ¥30,000

Enrollment fee: ¥282,000

Tuition: ¥297,300 per semester (¥594,600 per year)

*Please note that applicants in the self-funded category must have a solid financial plan to cover all the expenses, including living costs for the entire period of enrollment and the return flight ticket.

Qualifications of Applicants

1) Nationality: must have a non-Japanese nationality.

2) Education:

Applicants must fulfill one of the following conditions from ① to ⑤.

*If your application is based on ④ or ⑤, you must apply for the prior screening to validate your qualifications. Follow the guidelines on page 6.

- ① Hold a Bachelor's degree from a Japanese university or are expected to complete the degree at a Japanese university before the date of enrollment in GSST.
 - ② Completed or are expected to complete 16 years of formal education outside of Japan before the date of enrollment in GSST.
 - ③ Hold or are expected to complete a degree equivalent to a bachelor's degree from a three-year or longer program at a foreign university or other foreign educational institution before the date of enrollment in GSST. Universities or educational institutions from which applicants obtained or will obtain a degree must be accredited by a respective foreign government or someone certified by an appropriate foreign governmental agency, or so designated by MEXT.
 - ④ Completed 15 years of formal education outside of Japan and are recognized to have excellent academic records by GSST.
 - ⑤ Are recognized by GSST to have attainments equal to or higher than university graduates, and must be aged 22 years old or older before the date of enrollment in GSST.
- 3) Language: must have good English communication skills. The applicants should have an official score of either TOEFL iBT®, TOEIC®Listening & Reading Test, or IELTS Academic. The preferred minimum scores are 71 for TOEFL iBT®, 700 for TOEIC®Listening & Reading Test, and 6.0 for IELTS Academic. See "Required Documents 8)" for details.

Note:

- 1) Personnel with criminal records, or those on active military duty or reserve during the planned enrollment period at Kumamoto University are excluded.
- 2) The admission will be revoked if successful applicants fail to submit all necessary paperwork for admission by the designated date.
- 3) The admission will be revoked if successful applicants fail to fulfill the educational requirements as stated before the date of enrollment in GSST.

Application Procedure

Step 1

Contact a prospective supervisor in Kumamoto University and ask whether you can apply for IJEP Program under his/her supervision.

You can proceed to Step 2 before receiving an approval to apply from the prospective supervisor.



Step 2

Fill out E-application Form 1 (<https://forms.cloud.microsoft/r/J2Q49XC8um>) and submit it before October 16th, 2026 (for April 2027 Admission), or April 26th, 2027 (for Oct 2027 Admission). If your educational qualification is based on ④ or ⑤, prior screening (page 6) will be conducted. If you are not sure whether you need prior screening or not, please contact us at gsst-aas@jimu.kumamoto-u.ac.jp.



Step 3

After obtaining confirmation from the prospective supervisor in Step 1, please have face-to-face or online interviews with the prospective supervisor and at least two more faculty members from the related field(s). Interviews must be completed within one year prior to the application deadline. For more details about interview procedure, please contact your prospective supervisor.



Step 4

Upload the required documents in PDF format by the application deadline to the Proself link provided automatically upon Form 1 submission. (The password is provided in a separate email.)



Step 5

Fill out Form 2 and submit it. The link to Form 2 is provided in the auto-reply message after Form 1 submission.



Step 6

Once you receive an email that the documents have been checked, submit the original documents via express postal mail with tracking. If someone other than the applicant submits the original documents in person to the Academic / International Affairs Section, we may request their name and contact information.

Application Period

April 2027 admission: **September 18 to November 3, 2026**

[Application Deadline: Nov 3rd, 2026 Japan Standard Time (JST)]

October 2027 admission: **April 2 to May 14, 2027 [Application Deadline: May 14th, 2027 JST]**

Required Documents

- 1) Application Form for IJEP in the Graduate School of Science and Technology, Kumamoto University (format available on website). The applicant's signature must be handwritten. Printed or electronic signatures will not be accepted.

- 2) Statement of objectives written by the applicant. It should include reasons for application to the Graduate School, how the applicant qualifies to be a graduate student, and the applicant's academic, research, and professional goals.
- 3) A certificate of Bachelor's degree (or a certificate of anticipation of completion), or a copy of a diploma (original and English translation).
- 4) Official transcripts of academic records in English from each college and university attended, including information such as GPA and ranking.
- 5) A summary of Bachelor's thesis or an equivalent in English. An interim report is acceptable for applicants who have not yet graduated at the time of application.
- 6) A copy of the applicant's passport, or an official certificate of citizenship (original and English translation).
- 7) Two letters of recommendation in English from professors or research supervisors who can evaluate the applicant's academic and research abilities. Each letter must include the recommender's handwritten signature. Printed or electronic signatures will not be accepted.
- 8) An official score of TOEFL iBT®, TOEIC® Listening & Reading Test, or IELTS Academic. Scores are valid only if dated within two years of the application deadline. Submission of a score may be exempt, if the applicant completed a Bachelor's degree or other advanced degree where English is the primary language of instruction (an official document from the university for confirmation may be requested).
- 9) Proof of remittance of the examination fee (¥30,000 Japanese yen).

All bank charges (at least ¥2,500 yen or more) should be paid by the applicant. When you process the wire transfer to the following bank account, please be sure to tell your bank that you will pay for all charges of foreign banks. - 10) Application Checklist (format available on website).

Please make sure to confirm that you have all the documents by using the Application Checklist before sending the documents.

Note:

- 1) Applicants are advised to discuss research plans with their prospective supervisors beforehand.
- 2) All the documents should be typewritten on A4 size paper (21 x 29.5 cm).
- 3) Incomplete applications or applications submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.
- 4) All application documents will not be returned to the applicants.
- 5) There is no specified format for recommendation letters. However, the letter should be dated and include affiliation, position, signature or seal of the recommender.

- 6) The admission may be revoked, if it is determined that the applicant has made a false statement in the application.

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Prior Screening

<Guidelines for prior screening of qualification for application>

When your educational qualification is based on ④ or ⑤ on page 3, prior screening is required. Follow Step 1 and Step 2, and upload the required documents, (1)-① ②③④ below, to the link provided automatically upon the E-application [Form 1] submission during the submission period indicated below. If you pass the screening, upload the application documents on page 5 to the same link during the application period.

(1) Required documents for prior screening

- ① Application Form for IJEP in the Graduate School of Science and Technology, Kumamoto University (format available on website).
- ② A certificate of Bachelor's degree (or a certificate of anticipation of completion), or a copy of a diploma.
- ③ Official transcripts of academic records in English from each college and university attended, including information such as GPA and ranking.
- ④ A summary of Bachelor's thesis or an equivalent in English. An interim report is acceptable for

applicants who have not yet graduated at the time of application.
