Qualifications of Applicants

- 1) Nationality: must have a non-Japanese nationality.
- 2) Education:

Those who are expected to complete Master's Course in Kumamoto University in September 2019. (Students from their overseas home universities, who are completing GSST Master's Course of Double Degree Program in September 2019 and wishing to apply for Doctoral Course of IJEP for October 2019 admission, are excluded from this application.)

 Language: must have good English communication skills. The applicants should have an official score of either TOEFL, TOEIC, or IELTS. The preferred minimum scores are 530 for TOEFL-PBT (71 for TOEFL-iBT), 700 for TOEIC, and 6.0 for IELTS.

Application Procedure

Step 1

After obtaining a prospective supervisor's consent for this application, applicants should complete an interview in person with the prospective supervisor and at least two more faculty members from the related field(s) before the submission deadline. Please ask the prospective supervisor for scheduling and details of the interview.

Step 2

Submit the required documents to the International Affairs Section within the application period.

Application Period

October 2019 admission: April 15 to May 24, 2019

Required Documents

- Application Form for IJEP in the Graduate School of Science and Technology, Kumamoto University. (format available on website)
- Statement of objectives written by the applicant. It should include reasons for application to the Graduate School, how the applicant qualifies to be a graduate student, and the applicant's academic, research, and professional goals.
- 3) A certificate of anticipation of completion. This is not required for applicants in Master's Course of GSST.
- 4) An official transcript of Master's Course.
- 5) A summary of Master's thesis or an equivalent in English.
- 6) A copy of a residence card or a passport.
- 7) A letter in English from the employer indicating knowledge and consent of this application, if the applicant is employed at the time of application.
- 8) An official score of TOEFL, TOEIC, or IELTS, if the applicant's native language is not English. Scores are valid only if dated within two years of the application deadline. A score is not required, if applicants are completing Master's Course of IJEP.
- 9) Application Checklist (format available on website)

Please make sure to confirm that you have all the documents by using the Application Checklist before submitting the documents.

Note:

- 1) Applicants are advised to discuss research plans with their prospective supervisors beforehand.
- 2) All the documents should be typewritten on A4 size paper (21 x 29.7 cm).
- 3) Incomplete applications or applications submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.
- 4) All application materials will not be returned to the applicants.
