Receiving credits for Japanese language classes

Only bachelor's degree-seeking students and undergraduate level-exchange students can receive credits for lower-intermediate to advanced Japanese language classes (both compulsory subjects and elective subjects).

Learning elementary-level Japanese

Auditing intermediate/advanced Japanese classes

Graduate students, research students and special research students can take lower-intermediate to advanced Japanese classes. Note that you cannot receive any credits. However, a grade such as P (Pass), F (Fail), or X (drop) will be written on your transcript as an audit class. The grades for audit classes do not affect your GPA.
